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Light Dwells With God

Daniel praised the God of heaven and said . . . - Daniel 2:19-20

Daniel praises and honors God when the Lord has given him the answer to a problem that could never have been solved by human knowledge or human ability. Daniel realizes that all wisdom and strength come from God alone:

Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom and power are his. - Daniel 2:20

Physicist Charles H. Townes (1915-2015) is best known for his research in the development of masers and lasers. Townes was also a follower of Jesus who often spoke of his faith and how his faith helped him in his work. He often explained his faith by starting, "I believe in the existence of God, based on intuition, observations, logic, and also scientific knowledge."

When Charles was asked about "inventing" the laser, he mentioned the many other people who played important parts in it. He told a story about a beaver and a rabbit, which ended, "The beaver told the rabbit as they stared at the Hoover Dam, 'I didn't build it myself, but it's based on an idea of mine.'" Indeed, beavers were building dams, using what their Creator had given them, long before humans did. Similarly, anything good and constructive, whether an idea or a skill or anything else worthwhile, comes entirely as a gift of grace from our Heavenly Father:

He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others.
He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning. - Daniel 2:21

Townes was intrigued by light, both physical and spiritual. He writes, "When God said, 'Let there be light', he surely must have meant perfectly coherent light." Truly, God's light reveals thoughts too profound for human minds to have thought of. The most important truths do not come from human experts or human authorities, for our Heavenly Father himself teaches them to those who open their minds and hearts to him. God's words bring light to our souls, for light dwells with him:

He reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with him. - Daniel 2:22

Charles also spoke of God's nearness, and how he helps us in ways we might not even notice, "I feel the presence and intervention of a Creator beyond myself, but who is always nearby." Similarly, when the king hears that Daniel had solved the mystery, Daniel makes clear that it is not by human ingenuity or by human analysis that we understand God's truths, for God helps us understand them when we humbly and reverently follow Jesus:

Daniel replied, No wise man, enchanter, magician or diviner can explain to the king the mystery he has asked about, but there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries. - Daniel 2:27-28

We are so weak and we can understand so little, yet our Heavenly Father is so gracious to us all.
